[Important Notice for Applicants]

This is a notice about changes in Application Guidebook for Academic Year 2021(April Enrollment) due to the COVID-19. Please follow the new rules as below.

- The first-stage examination (on-site written examination) scheduled on January 28, 2021 is canceled. Furthermore, the exemption of written examination by thesis (or an alternative) submission is canceled. Rather than take the first-stage examination(on-site written examination), all the applicants will take the oral examination as explained below.
- 2. The second-stage examination (oral examination) scheduled on January 29, 2021, will be conducted on two days, January 28 and 29, 2021, for all applicants. The oral examination will be conducted online. Applicants will be contacted with further details at a later date.
- 3. All applicants will be required to submit an essay on a particular subject after the application period ends. The essay will be evaluated mainly in terms of logic rather than expertise. In addition, the essay will be subject to a question and answer period in the oral examination and will be evaluated as part of the entrance examination. The essay should be written in English or Japanese. The essay topics will be notified by email to applicants on December 14 (date subject to change), together with a template MS Word file for the essay and guidelines for writing as soon as the application acceptance procedure is completed. The deadline is 8:00 am on December 28 in Japan Standard Time (JST). Applicants will be contacted with further details at a later date.
- 4. The announcement of the examination results will be posted on the "Notice on the

Entrance Exam for AY 2020" section of the GSID website instead of being posted at the entrance of the GSID building. The announcement by mail will occur as scheduled.
