# How to count words of a manuscript

#### Create two word files from the original manuscript

#### File A: word file of text

- Main body
- Title
- Footnote
- Reference
- \* excluding abstract, author name and affiliation
- \* excluding titles, notes and sources of figures

File B: word file of figures, etc.

- Figures
- Tables
- Equations
- Appendix
- including titles, notes and sources of figures

### Count words in File A

Select "Word Count" by clicking "Review" → "Word Count" in the top toolbar, or "Words:" in the bottom status bar

2. Make sure "Include textboxes, footnotes and endnotes" is checked

3. The number after "Words" specifies the number of words in File A

### Count words in File B

The number of words in File B is computed by converting the length of File B to the number of words as follows:

1/2 page 270 Words

The total number of words of a manuscript is the sum of the following two numbers
