# Further Collaboration





### 1. The aim of the workshop

The Transnational Doctoral Programs for Leading Professionals in Asian Countries by the Asia Satellite Campuses Institute of Nagoya University (Asia Satellite Campus Program) offers special research-based doctoral programs, which primarily target professionals in government positions from the six countries that host its satellite campus facilities. This hybrid doctoral program provides opportunities for individuals who already have a master's degree to deepen their knowledge and experience and work towards a doctoral degree at one of Japan's top universities without having to take time out from their careers.

In Asia Satellite Campus Program, the Graduate School of International Development has admitted Ph.D. program students from Cambodia and the Philippines and has produced three Ph.D. holders. Five Ph.D. program students are engaging their research while conducting their day-to-day work as core professionals in their offices. All of them are expected to have a

leading role in their countries' further development and facilitate the research and education network of Nagoya university in the Asian region.

In this workshop, three Ph.D. students who have completed the program and one who will soon complete his research, their supervisors, and researchers from the Royal University of Phnom Penh are invited to discuss the following topics:

- a. Their achievement in their Ph.D. research and how their research and experiences in GSID are contributing to their current activities.
- b. Possibilities of further collaborations with GSID in research, education, and practical areas.
- c. Networking among GSID alumni, GSID students, and GSID staff.
- d. Promoting Asia Satellite Campus Program at GSID for potential candidates.
