

Asia Satellite Campus Program Second Stage Workshop II : The Way Forward to Further Collaboration



1. The aim of the workshop

The Transnational Doctoral Programs for Leading Professionals in Asian Countries, offered by the Asia Satellite Campuses Institute (ASCI) of Nagoya University (NU), provide specialized research-based doctoral programs primarily designed for professionals holding government positions in the six countries hosting its satellite campus facilities. This hybrid doctoral program presents an opportunity for individuals with a master's degree to deepen their knowledge and experience, pursuing a doctoral degree at NU without interrupting their careers.

Under the framework of the Asia Satellite Campus Program, the Graduate School of International Development (GSID) has admitted doctoral program students from Cambodia

and the Philippines, leading to the conferment of Ph.D. degrees to these professionals. ASCI-GSID students actively conduct research while fulfilling their responsibilities as core professionals in their respective offices, with the expectation that they will play dual roles in advancing their countries' development and fostering the research and education network of NU in the Asian region.

GSID is organizing an ASCI-GSID second stage workshop at the University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB) with the aim of understanding and appreciating the research progress of ASCI-GSID students and alumni. The workshop also seeks to strengthen collaborative efforts in education and research among the Philippines, Cambodia, and Japan. Participants in this workshop include two ASCI-GSID Ph.D. students close to completing their research, two GSID alumni who have completed the Ph.D. program, and researchers from UPLB, GSID, and the Royal University of Phnom Penh (RUPP). The discussions will cover the following topics:

- a. Their accomplishments in Ph.D. research and how their experiences at GSID are influencing their current activities;
- b. Providing incentives to ASCI-GSID Ph.D. candidates to complete their dissertations.
- c. Exploring possibilities for further collaborations with GSID in research, education, and development practices.
- d. Facilitating networks among UPLB, RUPP, and NU.
- e. Promoting the Asia Satellite Campus Program at GSID for potential candidates.
