3. How to Take the Course

The course will be taken using the THERS Learning Management System "TACT".

(1) Please access the TACT course screen from the URL below.

(2) Login the TACT.

1. Click on the  button in the upper-right corner of the screen.

2. Type in your THERS account UPN and Password, then click Login button.

How to change the system language

1. Read texts

Please click on the menu "テキスト/TEXT" on the left side of the screen and read and study the "3.e-Learning Tutorial for the Appropriate Use of Public Funds" and "4.Research Ethics Education e-Learning Program" text.

2. Take the Test

Click on the menu "テスト/TEST" on the left side of the screen. Click on the "e-Learning Tutrial for the Appropriate Use of Public Funds Test and Research Ethics Education e-Learning Program Test" title to take the test.

This test is divided into two parts.

1. Test for "e-Learning Tutorial for the Appropriate Use of Public Funds"(10 Questions)

2. Test for "Research Ethics Education e-Learning Program" (10 Questions)

Total:20 Questions

Each question is worth 5 points. A score of 90 or higher out of 100 (no more than 2 incorrect answers) is required to pass the test. A score of 85 or below (3 or more incorrect answers) will result failure.
