## Submission of a Master's Thesis in the 2025 Academic Year

Students who intend to earn a Master's degree either in September 2025 or in March 2026 are required to submit a master's thesis. Follow the timeline and instructions below:

Submissions intended for graduation in September 2025 or March 2026 will not be accepted after their respective deadlines. Should you be unable to upload the thesis onto TACT for some technical reasons of TACT, you must send it to the GSID Office by email before the deadline.

- Thesis and other documents to be submitted: Master's thesis
  Summary of the thesis: either 1,600 English words or 4,000 Japanese characters, approximately Confirmation Form for Plagiarism Check (designated form)
  Checklist for Master's Thesis Submission (designated form)
